

SOLAR BLANKETS

Solar Blankets heat by day and insulate at night. For optimum performance, leave the blanket on the pool when not in use for swimming. The blanket allows the sun's rays to pass through the bubbles to heat the pool water during the day - while the bubbles act as an insulator, minimizing heat loss at night.

Besides warmer water, energy savings and an extended swimming season, the blanket will result in a cleaner pool, reduce chemical usage and extensive water conservation. All of these things will amount to significant savings during the life of the blanket.

PROPER INSTALLATION

Install the blanket on the pool, bubble side down. The blanket should not overlap the sidewall, which could result in an opening for the wind to get under the blanket. A properly fitted blanket will be held down in place by the surface adhesion, requiring no tie-downs during windy periods and heavy rain.

PROPER CARE

The blanket should not be stored in an area where temperatures might reach 45 degrees. These extreme temperatures can expand the bubbles and cause delaminating and blistering - weakening the blanket.

Remove the blanket every time the pool is being chemically treated with shock and DO NOT put back onto the pool until safe concentration levels are reached (The levels of chlorine should not be over 3 parts per million).

If you do not have a Solar Blanket Reel, remove the blanket by using the "fanfold" technique. Simple pull a metre at a time over one end of the pool and continuously fanfold the blanket "accordion fashion" until the entire blanket is stacked next to the pool. The blanket can then easily be pulled back onto the pool in seconds.

CLEANING

Cleaning will allow more of the sun's rays to pass through the blanket to heat your pool. Clean with water and a soft brush. To keep the pool cleaner, hose off the dirt and leaves from the floating blanket directly into the pool skimmer.

Avoid putting the blanket on the lawn for any reason. The sun's rays passing through the bubbles will cause damage to the grass.

SOLAR BLANKET WARNINGS – AVOID DROWNING RISKS

- Stay off the blanket - it will not support weight.
- Keep children away. Children and/or objects cannot be seen under the blanket.
- Children can drown on top of the blanket.
- Remove blanket completely before entry of swimmers - entrapment is possible.
- Failure to follow all instructions may result in injury or drowning.
